Enjoy music and entertainment through out the day

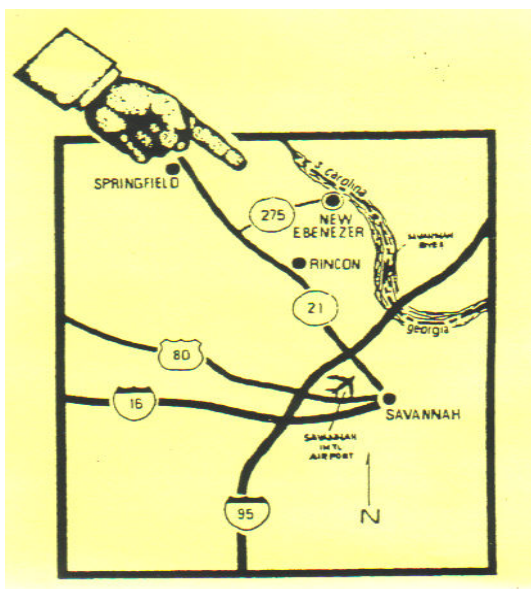
